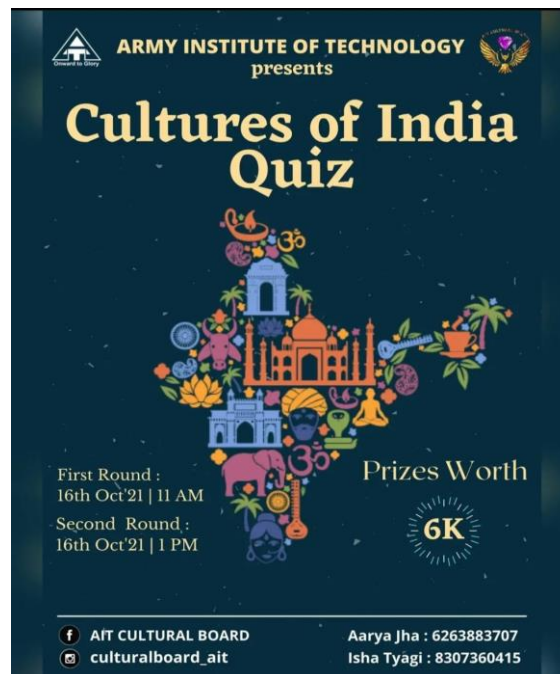
## **PRELUDE**
