Sub: AICTE approval to Army Institute of Technology, Pune.

Sir,

I am directed to state that on consideration of the recommendations made by the Central AICTE Task Force & Manpower Task Force for Maharashtra State, the All India Council for Technical Education has accorded conditional approval to the Army Institute of Technology, Pune. to conduct the following full time Degree courses for the academic year 1994-95 with annual intake shown against each :

SL. NO.	NAME OF THE COURSE	INTAKE
1.	Mechanical Engg.	60
2.	Electronics Engg.	60
3.	Computer Engg.	60

The above approval is subject to fulfillment of specific & general conditions as under:

Specific Conditions

1. The infrastructural and other facilities including faculty, equipment, books, etc. should be provided as per AICTE norms.
2. A Principal having qualifications, experience, etc. as per AICTE norms should be in position before admission of students.
3. One Professor and two lecturers in each discipline having qualifications, experience, etc. as per AICTE norms should be in position before admission of students.

4. The infrastructural and other facilities in terms of class rooms, tutorial rooms, labs, workshop, library, etc. as per AICTE norms for atleast First Year of the courses should be in position before actual admission of the students.
5. The infrastructural and other facilities in terms of reference labs, shops, books, etc. for subsequent years as per AICTE norms should be in position atleast six months in advance before actual start of classes of those years.
6. The teaching faculty strength should be raised to ultimate strength of 72 by appointing Professors and Lecturers as per AICTE norms maintaining the cadre proportion.

The AICTE scales of pay should be granted to the teaching faculty.

The approval is subject to full compliance with the Supreme Court Judgement dated 4.2.1993. Further the Army authorities should obtain clearance of their legal experts for only admitting sons and daughters of the army personnel vis-a-vis Supreme Court Judgement.

The institute shall provide an evidence of availability of affiliation of the courses from the respective university in their name before the start of session 1994-95.

7. The institute should get affiliation to the State Board of Technical education before actual admissions are made for academic year 1994-95.

General Condition

The Management including the Governing Body of the College shall be constituted, and its Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of AICTE.

No new courses shall be started or an ongoing course shall be discontinued by the institution without the prior approval of the AICTE.

The intake in any of the approved courses shall not be altered by the institution without the prior approval of the AICTE.

Appropriate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature as prescribed by the AICTE, including Endowment Fund, as prescribed by the AICTE.

Handwritten signature

All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per the AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.

Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.

The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria/limits prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.

The institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.

Admissions shall be made on merits and as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE.

The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society etc., shall be followed by the institution.

Institution by virtue of the approval by AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Governments.

Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as prescribed by the Competent Authority.

The Accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any agency authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or any body authorised by it.

The Institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AICTE.

Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICTE for ensuring maintenance of standards.


The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.

SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its

Judgments, and the related guidelines and criteria as may
be issued by the AICTE, UGC or the Central Government from
time to time.

In the event of non-compliance of the guidelines, norms
and conditions prescribed by the AICTE, the AICTE or a body
or person(s) authorised by it shall be free to take measures
for withdrawal of the approval or recognition, without
consideration of any related issues and that liabilities
arising out of such withdrawal would be solely that of the
Trust/Society and/or institution.

You are requested to kindly take necessary action to
implement the decision of the AICTE and communicate the progress
made in this regard to the Western Regional Committee (WRC) of
the AICTE under intimation to this office.
