### Environmental Conservation & Community Action

**Wildfire Awareness Programme** | February 10, 2026 The Department of Zoology, in collaboration with the Senapati District Forest Division and IQAC, conducted a successful awareness programme themed "**Our Forest, Our Responsibility.**"

\* **Expert Insights:** Shri Shanngam, IFS (DFO Senapati), and Dr. Lokho Puni, IFS (Retd.), addressed the environmental ethics of traditional farming and the rising threat of global warming.



- **Technical Management:** Smt. K. Chokhoni, Range Forest Officer (Mao Range), provided a technical breakdown of wildfire management. She utilized real-life case studies, specifically the recent blaze at **Mt. Esii**, to illustrate rapid response strategies and containment techniques.

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### Academic Field Visits & Political Research

**From Village Gates to Green Governance: Field Study at Khonoma | February 2026** The Department of Political Science, led by HoD Dr. Soreiphy K and Dean of Students Dr. Adani Kollo, undertook an immersive academic field visit to Khonoma, Nagaland—a historic site known as Asia's first "Green Village."





Accompanied by faculty member Chovoni Cheng and 44 students, the group explored the village as a "living political text." The visit focused on three core pillars of political thought:

- **Indigenous Self-Rule:** Students studied the *Khel* system (Thevo-ma, Merhu-ma, and Semo-ma), learning how traditional village councils exercise sovereignty and maintain collective security through the *Kharu* (traditional wooden gates).
- **Colonial Resistance:** The visit included a stop at the war memorials and reconstructed forts (notably the Semo-ma Fort), where students revisited the history of the Anglo-Khonoma War (1879–1880)—the final armed resistance of the Angami Nagas against British expansion.
- **Sustainable Leadership:** Once a "warrior village," Khonoma's transition into a global model for environmental stewardship was analyzed. Students met with local experts to discuss community-managed conservation and the Khonoma Nature Conservation and Tragopan Sanctuary (KNCTS).
