

Field of activity:

**Hazard to man and environment****Warning**

H290 May be corrosive to metals.  
H315 Causes skin irritation.  
H319 Causes serious eye irritation.

**Preventive measures and rules of conduct**

P102

Keep out of reach of children.

P234

Keep only in original container.

P260

Do not breathe vapors.

P302+P352

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of water/soap.

P305+P351+P338

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.



P337+P313

If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.

Provide good ventilation.

Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Take off immediately all contaminated clothing.

Do not breathe vapor or spray. Wear appropriate protective equipment.

Work place should be equipped with a shower and an eye rinsing apparatus.

After work, wash hands and face.

Respiratory protection:

Respiratory protection must be worn whenever the TLV (WEL) levels have been exceeded.

Half mask with particle filter P2/P3 according to OSHA Standard - 29 CFR: 1910.134 or ANSI Z88.2.

Hand protection:

Protective gloves according to OSHA Standard - 29 CFR: 1910.138.

Glove material: Nitrile rubber

Layer thickness: 0.11 mm.

Breakthrough time: &gt;480 min.

Observe glove manufacturer's instructions concerning penetrability and breakthrough time.

Eye protection:

Tightly sealed goggles according to OSHA Standard - 29 CFR: 1910.133 or ANSI Z87.1-2010.

Body protection:

Wear suitable protective clothing.

**Reaction in case of danger**

Avoid contact with the substance.

Do not breathe vapor or spray. Wear suitable protective clothing.

Ensure adequate ventilation, especially in confined areas.

Extinguishing media:

Product is non-combustible. Extinguishing materials should therefore be selected according to surroundings.

Accidental release measures:

Soak up with absorbent materials such as sand, siliceous earth, acid- or universal binder. Store in special closed containers and dispose of according to ordinance. Final cleaning.

To clean the floor and all object contaminated by this material, use water.

Field of activity:

**First aid**

In case of inhalation:	Move victim to fresh air. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.
Following skin contact:	Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. After contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of water. Seek medical attention.
After eye contact:	Immediately flush eyes with plenty of flowing water for 10 to 15 minutes holding eyelids apart. Subsequently seek the immediate attention of an ophthalmologist.
After swallowing:	Rinse mouth immediately and drink plenty of water. Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention.

**Appropriate disposal**

Waste key number	20 01 29* municipal wastes: Detergents containing hazardous substances * = Evidence for disposal must be provided.
Product:	Dispose of waste according to applicable legislation. Do not dispose of with household waste.
Waste key number (EU)	15 01 02 Plastic packaging: HDPE
Contaminated packaging:	Dispose of waste according to applicable legislation. Handle contaminated packages in the same way as the substance itself. Non-contaminated packages may be recycled.
