Hazard to man and environment



Warning

H319 Causes serious eye irritation.
H411 Toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects.

Preventive measures and rules of conduct



P102

Keep out of reach of children.

P260

Do not breathe dusts or mists.

P273

Avoid release to the environment.

P301+P310

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTER/doctor.

P305+P351+P338

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.



Dust should be exhausted directly at the point of origin.

Wash hands before breaks and after work.

When using do not eat or drink.

Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Do not breathe dust.

Have eye wash bottle or eye rinse ready at work place.

Respiratory protection:

When dust and vapors form: Use combination filter type A/P3 according to OSHA Standard - 29 CFR: 1910.134 or ANSI Z88.2.

Hand protection:

Protective gloves according to OSHA Standard - 29 CFR: 1910.138

Glove material: Nitrile rubber.

Observe glove manufacturer's instructions concerning penetrability and breakthrough time.

Eye protection:

Tightly sealed goggles according to OSHA Standard - 29 CFR: 1910.133 or ANSI Z87.1-2010.

Reaction in case of danger

Provide adequate ventilation. Wear personal protection equipment.

Avoid generation of dust. Do not breathe dust. Avoid contact with the substance.

Extinguishing media:

Product is non-combustible. Extinguishing materials should therefore be selected according to surroundings.

Accidental release measures:

Collect dry and place in appropriate containers for disposal. Subsequent cleaning.

To clean the floor and all object contaminated by this material, use water.

Field of activity:

First aid

In case of inhalation:	Provide fresh air. If breathing becomes irregular or ceases, apply rescue breathing or artificial respiration immediately, where required supply oxygen.
Following skin contact:	After contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of water. In case of skin irritation, consult a physician.
After eye contact:	Immediately flush eyes with plenty of flowing water for 10 to 15 minutes holding eyelids apart. Subsequently consult an ophthalmologist.
After swallowing:	Rinse mouth with water. Repeatedly drink water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Consult doctor afterwards. Do not induce vomiting.

Product:	MFSU = manufacture, formulation, supply and use Evidence for disposal must be provided. Dispose of waste according to applicable legislation. Smaller amounts: Dilute with plenty of water.
Waste key number (EU)	15 01 02 Plastic packaging
Contaminated packaging:	Rinse with water. Wrap waste as is appropriate for the type of material. Single packs can be disposed of together with household waste.
