

# The everyday hygiene for taps

## Postmix

The everyday tap cleaning is most useful before the closing hour  
We recommend the cleaning set for Coca Cola taps



### Working steps

Unscrew the spouts and the syrup distributors from the taps



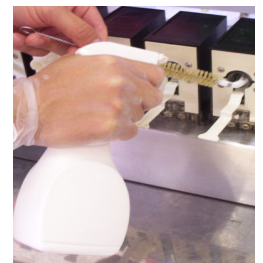
Clean coarse soiling with the brush.



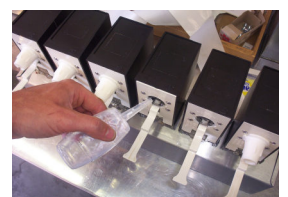
Thereafter, put the components with a cleaning ball into the graduated cleaning jug, filled with 500 ml of water.



Prepare the cleaning concentrate for the spray flask according to the instructions on the flask. Clean the lower section of the tap and the beverage outlet with the cleaning spray flask and the brush. Spray the cleaning compound diagonally.



Fill the cleaning ball with clean water and with it rinse the beverage outlet. Do not suck back the rinsing water into the cleaning ball.



**Do also clean the drip pan, dispenser column and the surrounding**

Before the opening hour you remove the components from the graduated cleaning jug and rinse them well with clean water.



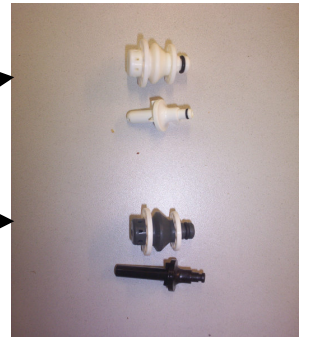
Put the cleaned syrup distributors and spouts back into the taps with your hands clean or using disposable gloves.



During installation pay attention to the order of the taps of the product-specific syrup distributor and spouts.

**Coca-Cola Light**



Pay attention that there are no residues of cleaning compound left on the taps prior to start using them, and also to the cleanliness of the cleaning devices. If required, the brush and the ball can be cleaned with the cleaning tab solution. Enter the cleaning activity into a cleaning schedule.

### **Hygiene also when changing the container**

When connecting new containers, it is important to clean the plug-on valve, the KEG or the Bag in Box connection.

Usually it is sufficient to use clean warm water for cleaning.

With this easy manipulation you will save the product from deterioration.

You avoid operating trouble and the connections are easier to join.
