

Field of activity:

### Hazard to man and environment



#### Warning

H319 Causes serious eye irritation.  
H412 Harmful to aquatic life with long lasting effects.

### Preventive measures and rules of conduct



P102

Keep out of reach of children.

P264

Wash hands and face thoroughly after handling.

P273

Avoid release to the environment.

P280

Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection.



P305+P351+P338

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

P337+P313

If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.

P501

Dispose of contents/container to hazardous or special waste collection point.

Provide adequate ventilation, and local exhaust as needed.

In case of dust formation: Withdraw by suction.

Avoid generation of dust. Do not breathe dust.

Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Change contaminated clothing.

Have eye wash bottle or eye rinse ready at work place.

After work, wash hands and face.

Wash hands before breaks and after work.

Respiratory protection:

In case of dust formation: Dust mask or Particulates filter P1 according to OSHA Standard - 29 CFR: 1910.134 or ANSI Z88.2.

Hand protection:

Protective gloves according to OSHA Standard - 29 CFR: 1910.138.

Glove material: Nitrile rubber-Layer thickness: 0,11 mm.

Breakthrough time: >480 min.

Observe glove manufacturer's instructions concerning penetrability and breakthrough time.

Eye protection:

Tightly sealed goggles according to OSHA Standard - 29 CFR: 1910.133 or ANSI Z87.1-2010.

Body protection:

Wear suitable protective clothing.

### Reaction in case of danger

Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid generation of dust.

Do not breathe dust. Suitable protective clothing. Have eye wash bottle or eye rinse ready at work place.

Extinguishing media:

Product is non-combustible. Extinguishing materials should therefore be selected according to surroundings.

Accidental release measures:

Collect dry and place in appropriate containers for disposal. Subsequent cleaning.

To clean the floor and all object contaminated by this material, use water.

Field of activity:

### First aid

In case of inhalation:	Provide fresh air. Seek medical treatment in case of troubles.
Following skin contact:	After contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of water. Change contaminated clothing. In case of skin irritation, consult a physician.
After eye contact:	Immediately flush eyes with plenty of flowing water for 10 to 15 minutes holding eyelids apart. Subsequently seek the immediate attention of an ophthalmologist.
After swallowing:	Rinse mouth and spit water out again. Repeatedly drink water. Do not induce vomiting. Danger of foam aspiration! Consult doctor afterwards.



### Appropriate disposal

Product:	Dispose of waste according to applicable legislation.
Contaminated packaging:	Rinse with water. Wrap waste as is appropriate for the type of material. Single packs can be disposed of together with household waste.
