Treasurers update: \$52,726.71 in Checking at STCU; \$5,250.00 in Savings at STCU; \$5,084.66 in Savings at Washington Trust. The Washington Trust account will be open until December due to payments made that have not been debited yet, account will be closed after everything has cleared.

Fiscal year for treasury is July 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup>. So far, \$18,76.14 has been received and \$27,462.74 has been spent this fiscal year.

A Venmo account is being created for donations.

Goal is to have 18,500 in savings at all times for the next years' field trips (approximately \$12,000) and teacher allocations (approximately \$6,200).
