Balanced Calendar Pilot

Adam presented details of the balanced calendar pilot, highlighting:

- School start date of August 26, 2026.
- A full week break in October and a week-long break in February.
- The pilot will run for two years with ongoing feedback from staff, students, and families.
- Middle school sports may continue during breaks with reduced programming.
- Adjustments will be made to support families needing childcare or programming during breaks.

AI in Education Discussion

Members discussed the role of artificial intelligence in education, including:

- Potential instructional benefits and risks.
- The importance of establishing clear classroom expectations.
- The need to educate families about AI use.
- Environmental considerations related to AI infrastructure.

A balanced, thoughtful approach to AI implementation was emphasized.
