

BRAG'S ACHIEVEMENTS TO DATE: May 2025

BRAG WAS NOMINATED AND WON A <u>PREMIER'S SUSTAINABILITY AWARD</u> IN 2023 AND A <u>TIDY TOWNS ENERGY</u> <u>AWARD</u> IN 2024.

- SOLAR LIGHTING: BRAG has installed solar lighting at Koolangarra Park, the Recreation Reserve and atop the Bunyip Centataph as well as ground lights to highlight the memorial....Thanks to Bunyip Community Shop and the Bunyip Market Committee for kind donations
- **RECREATION RESERVE:** We have worked with the **Recreation Reserve Committee and User Groups** to raise awareness via an **energy audit** and embark on a project to reduce the reserve's carbon footprint and lead the Bunyip Community in committing to create a sustainable future for the next generation.
 - We have successfully applied for grants to install a solar water pump to assist with irrigating the sports fields as well as solar panels on the Netball/Tennis pavilion... Thanks to Cardinia Shire Community Capital Works Grants.
- **RECYCLING:** We have organized and made the community aware of **local recycling** drop off points for hard to recycle items.
- **AFFILIATIONS:** We have **become active members** of Environment Victoria, Gippsland Climate Change Network, Baw Baw Sustainability Network, Cardinia Environment Coalition, Climate Action Network Australia and Yarra Energy Foundation.
- YARRA VALLEY COMMUNITY POWER HUB: during 2021-22 we participated on the steering committee which resulted in:
 - $\circ~$ Raising our profile
 - Training 4 of our members as **Home Energy Efficiency** providing assessments for local home owners.
 - Conducting a feasibility study into a **battery and small Solar Farm** on the Agricultural Society land to the south of the Recreation Reserve.... We still hope this project will become a reality.
- **COMMUNITY HALL:** BRAG supported the Hall Committee grant applications to install solar panels and split system heaters to replace existing gas heating for the Hall. Cardinia Shire will now add a battery to the Hall's solar system to improve community resilience.
- **COMMUNICATION:** We continue to provide our community with **regular updates** via our BRAG website, our community noticeboard, the Bunyip Facebook Page and the local newsletter.

We also continue to apply for funding to realise our vision of a Bunyip Community that sources 100% of its power from renewable sources.
