Following further consultation with RES (Renewable Energy Systems)

BRAG has made an in-principle decision to support this project with certain important provisos.

RES has officially launched their proposed project in both the Pakenham Gazette and our Bunyip Community Newsletter and is now preparing to embark on a meaningful community information and engagement program. Please watch this space for your opportunity to ask questions and provide local input over the next few months.

Whilst acknowledging the need for Battery Energy Storage Systems to stabilize the grid as we transition to renewable energy sources BRAG believes there are still a number of local issues that will need to be resolved and mitigation measures explained by RES to the community before they can gain the social license needed for their project to proceed:
