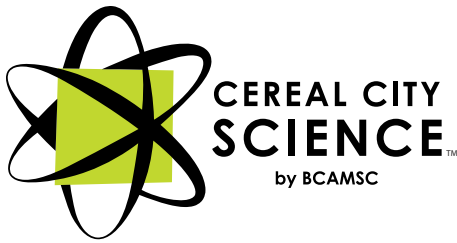
- You will need access to a computer or laptop
