

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Kenilworth Homestead

### **1. When are you open?**

- During school term – Open 2pm Friday – Close 10am Monday
- School and local public Holidays - Open every day

### **2. Do we need to book?**

- To avoid disappointment, it is always best to book online before you arrive. This also saves a lot of time at check-in.
- For major public holidays Easter, Christmas, long weekends and other special events it is always advisable to book online as early as possible. During these times we cap the number of people on the property.

### **3. Do you have toilets and showers?**

Yes, we have two ablutions blocks with toilets and hot showers. We also have four compost toilets closer to the river and bring in portable toilets during the busy times.

### **4. Are pets allowed?**

Yes, for camping only. Pets must be restrained on a lead by a responsible person always and cleaned up after.

### **5. Are open fires allowed?**

Yes, unless there is a total fire ban in place.

### **6. Are generators allowed?**

Yes, however only between the hours of 8am - 10am in the morning and 4pm - 6pm in the evening. This ensures campers can enjoy the peace and quiet.

### **7. Are Chainsaws allowed?**

Absolutely NOT.

### **8. Are motorbikes allowed?**

No. Unregistered motocross / trail bikes (of any size) or any other unregistered vehicle are not permitted to be ridden/driven on the property. We do highly recommend Park Lands MotoX track which is less than 3km from the Homestead. <http://parklandsmx.com.au/>

### **9. Do you have a dump point for chemical toilets?**

No, however there is an official Unity Water dump point at Kenilworth Hall, Show & Recreation Ground



Elizabeth St – Kenilworth. Entry is through the main gate (next to the Swimming Pool), turn left at the first track, and the dump point is on your left.
