


An all-inclusive experience with accommodation!

At Leona Amarga, we are now offering a 100% personalized experience with accommodation for guests who are doing activities with us. We are located just 5 minutes drive from The Land of the Pumas, the area where we operate, and from our guest house, we have a beautiful view of the three iconic towers of the National Park, Torres del Paine.









We are located in a remote, dry area with limited resources like water and electricity, and we are therefore very conscious about the use of these two resources. It is therefore very important that our guests are aware of and accept these conditions when staying at Leona Amarga.

The water we use for the showers, toilets, and the dish wash comes from a natural water source, not far from the property, and we collect it in a water tank at Leona Amarga. There are no water pipes or running water at the property, we, therefore, encourage our guests to be conscious about the use of water by taking short showers. Electricity comes from our solar panels (220V) that provide light and electricity for minor equipment e.g. charging batteries, and refrigerators, but not for household devices like hair dryers and electric kitchen equipment. We do not use generators to minimize the use of combustibles and noise.

We try to recycle as much as we can by dividing trash into organic trash for compost, carton, paper, bottles, and cans, and we encourage our guests to do the same.



About the place





The dome is 7 meters in diameter and consists of 2 single beds, bed tables, and a living area with a table and chairs.

As heather, we have installed a wood pellet stove. Connected to the dome is the bathroom.

There is the option of 2 single beds, or to put these two beds together as a Super King bed.
