Main Activities:

 Drive company vehicles with canoe trailers and collect canoes and all other associated equipment from designated locations along the river.



- Transport customer luggage to overnight accommodation (customers participating in multi day trips) Also collection on the following day.
- End of trip logistical operations, meet and greet customers at their end location and assist them in their return to their start point – respond to events and changes to plans as they occur.
- Cleaning of all equipment after use.
- Carry out vehicle checks and basic weekly maintenance.

Special Conditions:

- Working hours will include weekends and bank holidays.
