

Chungeum Ear Terms of Service

Article 1 (Purpose)

These Terms of Service (“Terms”) set forth the rights, obligations, and responsibilities between **Wonder Meditech Co., Ltd.** (the “Company”) and users in connection with the use of the **ChungeumEar Show** mobile application (the “Service”) provided by the Company, as well as other matters necessary for the use of the Service.

Article 2 (Definitions)

1. “Service” refers to all services through which audio streaming content is provided via the mobile application operated by the Company.
 2. “User” refers to any person who agrees to these Terms and uses the Service.
 3. “Device” refers to equipment that transmits audio content at specific locations such as concert venues, lecture halls, or movie theaters.
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Article 3 (Effectiveness and Amendment of the Terms)

1. These Terms shall become effective upon being posted on the Service screen or otherwise made available to Users.
 2. The Company may amend these Terms to the extent permitted by applicable laws and regulations. In such cases, the Company shall notify Users in advance by specifying the effective date and the reasons for the amendment.
 3. If a User does not agree to the amended Terms, the User may discontinue use of the Service.
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Article 4 (Provision and Modification of the Service)

1. The Company provides real-time audio streaming services to Users.
2. The Service may be used without any membership registration, and the Company does not require Users to provide personally identifiable information.
3. The Company may modify the content or operation of the Service, and in such cases, advance notice shall be provided.

Article 5 (Restriction on Use of the Service)

The Company may restrict or suspend use of the Service if any of the following applies:

1. Violation of applicable laws or these Terms;
2. Interference with the normal operation of the Service; or
3. Any other circumstance in which the Company reasonably deems such action necessary.

Article 6 (Intellectual Property Rights)

1. All copyrights and intellectual property rights related to the Service and its content belong to the Company or the rightful owners.
2. Users may not reproduce, distribute, modify, or commercially exploit any part of the Service or its content without the prior consent of the Company.

Article 7 (Disclaimer)

1. The Company shall not be liable for any failure or interruption in the provision of the Service due to force majeure events such as natural disasters, communication failures, or system errors.
2. The Company shall not be liable for issues arising from the User's device environment or network conditions.

Article 8 (Governing Law and Jurisdiction)

These Terms shall be governed by the laws of the Republic of Korea. Any disputes arising in connection with the Service shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the court having jurisdiction over the Company's principal place of business.
