Note from the Pastor

Jesus prayed this prayer for all of us in John17:20-23, "My prayer is not for the disciples alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent Me. May they may be one as we are one: I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me."

If you are a follower of Jesus Christ, your spiritual ancestry dates back to the original 12 disciples: yes, Peter, James, and John, and the other 9 are at the top of your spiritual ancestry chart! Their message never wavered: Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except thru Jesus! Christ crucified, Christ resurrected, and Christ returning. The gist of this prayer for us lies in the word unity. 3 times in this short prayer, Jesus prays for all believers to be one, to be brought to complete unity, just as He and the Father are completely unified. Why does Jesus pray for unity? He knew it would be a struggle for us. He knew we would bump heads with one another out of selfish ambition and "being right". He knows the greatest weapon used against the church today is division. So to keep the enemy at bay, Jesus prays for the power of unity to be in our midst. And the power of unity is found in a simple spiritual equation: UNITY EQUALS SALVATION! We saw this play out at our Unity Service on June 13th.

At the 8:30 service, we saw Terry and Jeannie Waggoner become part of our church family, Jeannie thru transfer of membership and Terry by confession of faith. We are thrilled that the Waggoner's are "family". At the 10:00 service, Tiffany, one of our former youth members came forward and gave her life to Christ. While greeting people on the way out with Tiffany, a young lady named Melanie, who had come to church that morning with her mom and sisters, who attend Central Community Church, looked me straight in the eye and exclaimed, "I want to be baptized!" After a brief gospel presentation, Melanie prayed with me at the back of the sanctuary and received Jesus as her Lord and Savior. She and Tiffany were both baptized that morning in Campbell Hall, a fellowship hall named after a man who preached and yearned for unity among believers. Alexander Campbell understood the equation!

As of this writing, a third baptism has just taken place today, June 15th. I will tell you, I am on a spiritual high right now! Terry Waggoner, having grown up around Lake Paradise, asked if there was a possibility that he be baptized in the lake. Having never performed an outdoor baptism, I joyfully replied, "Let's do this!" With family present, Terry was baptized at Lake Paradise in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is moving. Let us not impede His movement.

Psalm 133:1, "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!
