**PROPOSAL TO AMEND TITLE 19 "ZONING" TO ADD PERMANENT
COSMETICS AS A LAND-USE AND ESTABLISH A DEFINITION**

**PROPOSAL TO AMEND TITLE 19 "ZONING", CHAPTER 19.02 "DEFINITIONS",
AND CHAPTER 19.06 "LAND USE REGULATIONS", SECTION 19.06.000
"TABLES 6-1, 6-2, AND 6-3" TO ADD PERMANENT COSMETICS AS A LAND-
USE AND ESTABLISH A DEFINITION**

WHEREAS, it is the interest of the City to add terminologies and clarification to the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, definitions for permanent cosmetics and tattooing, and adding permanent cosmetics to the Table of Land Use Regulations 6-1 and 6-2 codifies how the land-uses have been administered; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the Planning Commission's recommendation and has received pertinent information in the public hearing regarding the proposal; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the public hearing and upon making the necessary reviews, the Council of Layton City finds it to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens to make the proposed amendments to Layton Municipal Code Title 19.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Layton City, UT as follows:

SECTION 1: Repealer. If any provisions of the municipal code previously adopted are inconsistent herewith they are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: Amendment. Section "19.02.020 " is hereby amended as follows.

...

"Parking Space, Off Street": ... parking of one vehicle.

"Payday Loan Business": means ... of wages as collateral.

"Permanent Cosmetics" : means a semi-permanent application of pigments under the skin for areas of the body such as the eyebrows, eyelids, lips, and/or other parts of the body for beauty marks, hair imitation, lash enhancement, or for medical purposes. The cosmetic implantation technique deposits pigment in between the epidermis and dermis. Permanent cosmetics include permanent makeup, micro-pigmentation, micro-pigment implantation, micro blading, dermagraphics.

"Person with a Disability": ... to, a residential neighborhood.

SECTION 4: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this amendment is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be severed and such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this amendment.

SECTION 5: Effective Date. This ordinance being necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the City, shall go into effect at the expiration of the 20th day after publication or posting or the 30th day after final passage as noted below or whichever of said days is the more remote from the date of passage thereof.
