



## Build a Biome in a Box

**Biomes** are large areas with similar **weather patterns**, **animal species**, and **plantlife**. In this activity, your students will pick a biome and create a box diorama to represent it. Learning about the world's biomes is an important prerequisite for understanding how they may be affected by climate change.

Students are also asked to write a **fun fact** about their biome on the side of their box. They should also write about how their biome will likely be affected by climate change.

### Biomes

**These are nine major biomes:**

- Tropical rainforest
- Savannah
- Desert
- Temperate forest
- Tundra
- Taiga/Boreal forest
- Grasslands
