Climate Activism

This activity is designed to **introduce** students to the concept of **climate activism** by providing examples of notable **climate activists**. By learning about a small handful of the **many** climate activists around the world, students may feel **empowered** and **inspired** to take **climate action** themselves. This will also allow students to practise their research, analysis and presentation skills.

Instructions

Each student/pair/group should select **one** of the climate activists from the list that is provided. Students will then be given time to prepare a poster board about their chosen climate activist's **work** and **background**. They can later **present** their poster to the class. We recommend that each student/pair/group select a **different** climate activist so that the presentations don't become too repetitive.
