## Solve Climate Change While Acting

The purpose of this activity is for your students to practise their **drama skills** but with a **climate change** twist! You will need to split the class into 5 groups so that each group has a unique story to perform.

Each story explains a little bit about the life of someone around the world who is **suffering** from **climate change**. Your students' task is to spend 20 minutes planning a **dramatisation** of the story that ends with a **positive** outlook on our future that is incorporated into the performance. Their plays should be 2 minutes long and should encompass elements of **theatre** such as **intonation**, **tone**, **volume**, **mood**, **silence**, **stillness** and **action** to add **impact**. The students do not have to fully adhere to the character stories provided; they can elaborate on the existing details, add their own information, or just use the characters and situations as **inspiration**.
