WORSHIP

WORD

WE HAVE BEEN STUDYING HOW DAVID RECOVERED:

1. He strengthened himself in the Lord - God part
2. He inquired of God for wisdom - God part
3. He pursued - his part with God
4. He fought until he recovered all - his part

EVERY DELIVERANCE HAS A GOD PART AND A MAN PART

QUESTION 1: What role does prayer play in our process of recovery?

Answer: We find ourselves in primarily a spiritual battle! Prayer is always our first resort!

Ask a few cell members to read 2 Corinthians 10:3-4; Ephesians 6:10; Zechariah 4:6

QUESTION 2: We all acknowledge that prayer is a vital part of our recovery process. When it comes to recovering all the enemy tried to take from us, would you say that prayer is the only thing we should do? What should we do after we prayed?

Answer: This is where many Christians miss it. They pray... and then do nothing! David prayed... then pursued... then fought UNTIL he recovered all. He did not pray... went to bed and the next day everything he lost just somehow supernaturally came back.

IF WE WANT TO RECOVER ALL, WE HAVE TO BE VERY PRO-ACTIVE DOING OUR PART, APPLYING GOD'S WORD IN OUR LIVES!

Ask a cell member to read James 1:22

QUESTION 3: Why do you think James said that if we don't do the word, we deceive ourselves?

Ask a cell member to read 2 Chronicles 26:3-10, 15

QUESTION 4: From this passage we see how industrious Uzziah was. How does this passage relate to Daniel 11:32b?

Answer: When we connect with God like Uzziah did:

- *we will receive ideas of witty inventions*
- *we will turn the world upside down like early believers*
- *we will become unstoppable*
- *we will do great exploits for our God*

EVERY DELIVERANCE IN THE BIBLE WAS ACCOMPANIED BY ACTION AFTER PRAYER

Ask a cell member to read 2 Kings 4:1-7

QUESTION 5: From what we've learned the past few weeks, what would you say brought the victory/breakthrough in this situation in 2 Kings 4?

Answer: This widow could have used her circumstances as an excuse for failure. But she chose to respond to a word of the man of God. She responded through taking action.

QUESTION 6: Why would you say is it so important that we get up and do something?

*Answer: 1. Nothing just happens by itself
2. Although God brings deliverance... it is because someone responds to His instruction:*

- *Someone prayed*
- *Someone heard a word from God*
- *Someone actioned a God-plan*
- *Someone sowed the right seed*

WORKS

Read Matthew 18:12-13. The past few weeks' messages were to encourage members to stand up and to recover what the enemy has stolen from them. But this is also a call for us to recover Kingdom losses: to recover the lost, to recover the backsliders, to recover those who have fall by the road. As a cell, set up a recovery plan to win back those who are no longer committed to the homecell and the church. Go all out to WITHOUT FAIL, RECOVER EVERY PERSON/FAMILY.
