WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell.

WORSHIP

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering (1 Praise & 2 Worship songs)

WORD

Ask a cell member to read 1 Samuel 30:1-8

The past week we've been praying and trusting God to RECOVER ALL. Ask a few cell members to share their past week's experiences and breakthroughs with the rest of the homecell.

QUESTION 1: How important is a "get-up-on-the-inside" attitude if we want to recover all?

Isaiah 41:1 The Message

"Quiet down, far-flung ocean islands. Listen! Sit down and rest, everyone. Recover your strength. Gather around me. Say what's on your heart. Together let's decide what's right."

Remember the following:

- People in fatigue will never win any battles
- · Before David even inquired of the Lord or pursued the enemy, he recovered himself
- We need to gather ourselves before we will gather anything out there

QUESTION 2: What do we need to practically do to get up on the inside?

Today we'll look at the 2nd thing we need to do in order for us to recover all: **GETTING GOD'S MIND TO RECOVER**

Ask a cell member to read 1 Samuel 30:7-8

QUESTION 3: What did David do after he strengthened himself in the Lord?

Answer: After David recovered himself in the Lord, he sought the mind of God regarding his situation.

Habakkuk 2:2-3 Message Bible

²⁻³ And then God answered: "Write this. Write what you see. Write it out in big block letters so that it can be read on the run. This vision-message is a witness pointing to what's coming. It aches for the coming—it can hardly wait! And it doesn't lie. If it seems slow in coming, wait. It's on its way. It will come right on time.

QUESTION 4: So many people, even Christians, try to figure things out on their own. They seldom involve God in the process. Why is it so critical to get God's mind regarding your situation?

Answer: A "rhema word" becomes the foundation of your faith. Romans 10:17 says: "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." Our faith is rooted in the word/promise of God.

* "Rhema" is a Greek word describing a word received from God that becomes a revelation to you at that very moment. Sometimes when you read the Bible a scripture or statement "jumps out" to you or grabs a hold of your heart. You get the sense that God is saying this to you right now. This word then becomes a revelation to you and becomes the foundation upon which your faith is build.

THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR A "RHEMA WORD" FROM GOD. WHEN YOU GET A "RHEMA WORD" FROM GOD, IT IS A DONE DEAL!

Ask a few cell members to read 2 Samuel 5:17-25; Luke 5:4-8; 1 Kings 17:1-16

QUESTION 5: What is the one thing that stands out in every one of the passages we just read?

Answer: It is clear that David, Peter and Elijah got clear instructions from God on how to deal with their situation. Their obedience to the "rhema word" of God caused their breakthrough.

GOD KNOWS EXACTLY HOW TO ORCHESTRATE YOUR DELIVERANCE AND HOW TO GUIDE YOU INTO YOUR SEASON OF RECOVERY.

Ask a cell member to read James 1:2-8; Ecclesiastes 10:10; Proverbs 4:5-7

QUESTION 6: These scriptures talk about the importance of getting wisdom? How would you define wisdom?

Answer: Wisdom is a supernatural gift from God where the Holy Spirit imparts God's insight and understanding into your heart.
