Brief Leader Devotional

As you lead students to learn more about Jesus, take time to remember who Jesus was working in your life. Take a few minutes to reflect on the major times in your life where Jesus had a great impact on you. This could be a time of crisis where he showed up or gave you strength. This could be a time where you just felt the love and presence of the Lord in a powerful way.

Read through Psalm 107:1 and 1 Thessalonians 5:18. Take time in prayer giving thanks to the Lord for the good things and love he has displayed. Seek to be as specific as you can in your thanks to him.

We can only take the students at club as far as we have come in our walk with Jesus., It's important that we give thanks consistently to the Lord, always remembering what he has done for us. This helps us to build a foundation of trust so that we can trust the Lord when new trials and challenges come our way. We can also seek to be an example that students can follow each week at club.

- Who is Jesus and The Gospel Hand are great resources to teach students about Jesus. Who is Jesus is a great large group resource and The Gospel Hand is a great small group resource.
- While in small groups using personal examples will help you build connections with students. It is also a great tool to deepen the point you are seeking to teach. Sharing testimonies and personal stories has been an effective way to teach for centuries! Share your story with students. If you have built a strong relationship with them, hearing your stories will help engage them in the lesson.
