

Lessons include:

Theme: This series is designed to inspire students by exploring the lives and legacies of heroes who have made a significant impact through their faith in Jesus. This series will be divided into four sections, each focusing on a different type of hero: Community Heroes, Old Testament Heroes, New Testament Heroes, and Heroes from Christian History. The final week will challenge and equip students to consider how they can become heroes of the faith in their own lives.

Brief Leader Devotional

Life at home can shape so much of who we are. While homes can be places of love and joy, they can also bring challenges and pain. God offers us something unique: a perfect relationship as a Heavenly Father. This month, kids will explore what it means to be loved by God, who calls them His children, no matter their circumstances.

Leader Challenge: Take a moment to reflect on your own family life and how it has impacted your faith. If your earthly family brought challenges, how has your relationship with God brought healing? If your family life was joyful, how has it reflected God's love? Reflect on how you've experienced God as a Father to help the kids connect to this truth.

Read *Psalms 68:5–6* and spend time thanking God for His perfect, fatherly love. Pray for the kids to feel safe and loved by God in the midst of these lessons.

Helpful Tips

1. **Be Sensitive:** Some children may come from difficult family situations. Be careful to affirm God's love for every child, no matter what their earthly family is like.
2. **Encourage Sharing:** Kids may want to share stories about their home life. Be a good listener and redirect them to the comfort found in God's love.
3. **Practical Application:** Help kids think of one way they can share God's love in their home this week—through kindness, forgiveness, or prayer.

Leader Reminder

God's perfect love is a powerful truth for kids to hear, especially those facing challenges at home. Pray for God to use you as a reflection of His love this week.
