Brief Leader Devotional

The story of Adam and Eve reminds us of the devastating impact of sin but also points to God's plan of redemption. While sin separates us from God, He has always provided a way for us to return to Him through Jesus.

Leader Challenge: Reflect on how sin has impacted your life and how God's provision through Jesus has brought restoration. When is a time in your life where God's forgiveness has changed you?

Read *Romans 5:12–21* and thank God for His plan to rescue us from sin. Pray for the kids to understand the seriousness of sin and the hope found in God's love.

Helpful Tips

- **Be Sensitive:** Some kids may struggle to understand sin or feel scared by its consequences. Reassure them that God's love and forgiveness are always available.
- **Focus on Hope:** While the lesson covers the seriousness of sin, emphasize the promise of Jesus and God's plan to rescue us.
- **Encourage Questions:** Create a safe space for kids to ask questions about sin, forgiveness, and God's love.
