Course Goals & Objectives:

- Arch 514B presents an overview of the history of architecture from the 16th century to the present from a global perspective, with the following objectives: To provide students with a fundamental understanding and level of literacy in the theories, topics, names, terms, and ideas of the historical period being studied.
- To make students aware of the fact that architecture is the product of social, cultural, religious, and political forces and cannot be understood without introducing those issues and studying their place in the historical topic being analyzed. To make students aware of the fact that, at any given point in time, great cultures and civilizations have existed all over the world, not just in one part of it. Cultures and civilizations have interacted and now do so more than ever, which means that there is a great deal more complexity to the world history of architecture than has typically been conveyed by the more conventional Eurocentric history courses offered in the past.
