

Your IPAL advisor has notified us that you are enrolled in an IPAL option at your university. You will need to take the following steps to set up your account and request eligibility to test.

1. To get started, you will need to grant your IPAL advisor permission to access your experience and exam progress.

- This is done by linking your NCARB Record to IPAL through the email sent by NCARB (pictured below).
- 2. Click Set Up Your NCARB Account in the email sent by NCARB.
 - If you already have an NCARB Record, you should still use the Set Up link sent by NCARB to link your existing account to the IPAL program.



Grant your IPAL advisor access to your experience and exam progress.

Your IPAL advisor has notified us that you are enrolled in University of Maryland's Master of Architecture IPAL option.

To allow your IPAL advisor to access your progress through the Architectural Experience Program[™] (AXP[™]) and Architect Registration Examination® (ARE®), you must first set up a free My NCARB account. Once you have established your username and password, you will be prompted to grant your advisor access. If you already have an NCARB account, you will have the option to link your account with our IPAL enrollment list.

3. After clicking the link in the email, you will be directed to the setup page (pictured below).

- If you already have an NCARB Record, you should <u>not</u> activate a new account. You will need to click the link in the upper blue box "Login to Link Your IPAL Initiative Enrollment Information."
- > That link will lead you to the NCARB login page.
- If you do not remember your NCARB username or password, you can request your login credentials on that page.

If you have already been made eligible to test in a jurisdiction, then you are <u>not</u> eligible to participate in the IPAL program. You will need to contact your IPAL Advisor to be removed from the IPAL option.

If you are eligible to test through IPAL, you will need to:

- Log into your NCARB Record and select the Exams tab
- Request Eligibility
- Select 'IPAL' as your Testing Jurisdiction
- > Do <u>not</u> select a state or any jurisdiction other than IPAL
