## **STAFF UPDATE**

### **2017 Stellar Communities Designation**

In October, the Town of Culver was chosen as a 2017 Stellar Communities Designee. The Stellar Communities Designation Program is a partnership between multiple agencies, designed to recognize smaller communities in Indiana that have worked to identify a strategy for comprehensive community and economic developments. The Town of Culver's Strategic Investment Plan includes providing workforce housing through the Sand Hill Farm Development, extending the Lake Maxinkuckee bike and pedestrian trail, renovating the Beach Lodge, and making improvements to the western gateway into Culver. A Stellarbration will be held on November 8, from 4:30 to 6:30 pm to celebrate Culver's designation.

### **INDOT Rural Call for Projects**

There is an INDOT Call for Projects for rural areas, which include non-urbanized areas of St. Joseph and Elkhart Counties, as well as all of Marshall and Kosciusko Counties. The applications are due to MACOG for review by November 8, for projects seeking construction in SFY 2022.

**MACOG Urban Call for Projects**

The MACOG Call for Projects is due to MACOG by December 13, 2017. Project selections will be made in February 2018. The call is for Group I, Group II, TAP, HSIP, and CMAQ projects. This call for projects is for both existing project and new project requests. **MACOG Regional Economic Development District Meeting (MREDD), December 13, Wyndham Garden Hotel, Grand Ballroom, Warsaw**

The MACOG Regional Economic Development District Meeting (MREDD) will be held on December 13, immediately following the Policy Board Meeting, beginning at 10 am. There will be dialogue and updates from leaders of our local Economic Development Organizations, along with an update on the VW settlement and what it means for the MACOG region. This year the meeting will be held at the Wyndham, in Warsaw. Lunch is included and will begin at noon. The TTAC members were invited to attend.

**2020 Census**

The 2020 Census is soon approaching, with much of the preparation starting well in advance. Communities that plan to participate in the Local Update of Census Addresses (LUCA) Program need to register by December 15, 2017. It will give communities the opportunity to review census information, so as to obtain accurate addresses and a complete count. As local communities continue to register for the program, it is feasible that census staff will host a LUCA training session in Northern Indiana.

MACOG will continue to update each jurisdiction concerning the next steps on different programs in the census process. Remember, not only does the census provide important demographics, fiscal, and statistical information about our communities, but it also decides representation in congress that determines federal formula funding. 
