Staff Update

New MACOG Staff Member – Brett Roberts
 James Turnwald introduced Brett Roberts a new MACOG employee as a
 Community Development Planner. Brett then gave a brief synopsis of himself.
 He stated his role would focus on economic resiliency.

Grants

- MACOG Call for Projects Awards Caitlin Stevens stated that over \$34 million dollars were awarded for projects through Fiscal Year 2028. She explained that most had been added into the TIP, but two additional projects will be added.
- Or INDOT Call for Projects Update Caitlin told the members that about six projects were submitted for the Rural call for projects. Caitlin informed members that INDOT would be hosting two meetings; January 13th for the Fort Wayne district and January14th for LaPorte district so that the districts can give presentations on their projects.

Caitlin then mentioned that INDOT released the next Community Crossings grant, which will be due by the end of January.

OCRA's Community Connection for People with Disabilities – Due January 10 James Turnwald stated that the final applications are due by January 10. The local government working with non-profit agencies who work with peoples with disabilities to help them with technology. He said that Goshen is working on a sensory trail. James also let them know that this opportunity is outside the entitlement funding.

Recreational Trails Program – Due March 1
 Alaina explained how the Recreational Trail deadline is March 1. This grant can fund trail amenities, trailheads, and land acquisitions. There is a twenty percent match opened to non-profits or government.

Plans and Programs

 Marshall County Parks Master Plan
 Donny Ritsema explained that MACOG is providing technical planning services to the Marshall County Park Board. MACOG will help them develop their first five-year parks master plan. They will create a mission, vision and identifying needs.

° FY 2022-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Caitlin Stevens stated that there would be a draft list of projects for review in February to update the TIP. The new TIP will be from 2022-2026. The full narrative should be out in March for public comment. The final product will go to the TTAC and Policy Board in April.
