Staff Update

Grants and Funding

INDOT Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for Local Bridge Preventative Maintenance Projects Allyson said INDOT will be issuing a NOFA for local bridge preventative maintenance type projects on January 2, 2023. To be eligible, LPAs must have an approved Bridge Asset Management Plan (AMP). The Bridge AMP must be submitted by December 16, 2022, and can be emailed to INDOTLPAMPO@indot.IN.gov. Allyson also stated LTAP is hosting a webinar today for anyone interested.

INDOT Community Crossings Matching Grant (CCMG)

Allyson said the CCMG applications will open January 3, 2023, and close January 27, 2023. To be eligible, LPAs must have submitted a Pavement AMP by December 1, 2022. Please reach out to Allyson or Caitlin with any questions or if assistance is needed.

Indiana Trails Grant

Dustin stated that the applications for the Indiana Trails Grant are due March 1, 2023. The Indiana Trails Program (ITP) will provide a maximum of 80% reimbursement for eligible projects. At the time of application, the applicant must have at least 20% of the total project cost available. Eligible projects include construction of trials, acquisition of easement or property for trails, development of trailheads and other support facilities and construction of bridges, boardwalks, and crossings.

Plans and Programs

Regional Freight Mobility Plan

Caitlin provided an update on the Regional Freight Mobility Plan. She stated the final draft of the "Priorities for Improvement" is almost complete. The final draft will be presented to the Steering Committee for review before going out for public comment.

Michiana on the Move: 2050 Transportation Plan

Caitlin stated there is a survey and comment map available until mid-January regarding the 2050 Transportation Plan. Caitlin said they have also been working on developing scenarios for the plan and the goal is to present that information in the beginning of the year.

January Quarterly Tracking and Review Meeting

Allyson stated the next quarterly tracking meeting will be January 12, 2023. Carla will send an email reminder to everyone.

CONNECT Transit Plan

Zach said the last phase of the CONNECT Transit Plan process has started and a draft recommendations plan was created with the consultant. There is a survey launching today and a stakeholder meeting will be held tomorrow.
