Staff Update

Grants and Funding

OCRA's Quarter 1 CDBG Planning Grant

Sofia Gladun stated the Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA) is opening the Community Development Block Grant Planning Program on January 13, 2023. Applications are due on February 15, 2023.

Indiana Trails Grant

Dustin New said the Indiana Trails Grant applications are due March 1, 2023. The Indiana Trails Program will provide a maximum of 80% reimbursement for eligible projects and applicants may request a minimum of \$100,000 and maximum of \$400,000 in grant assistance.

INDOT Community Crossings Matching Grant (CCMG)

Allyson said the CCMG applications opened on January 2, 2023, and will close on January 27, 2023. To be eligible, LPAs must have submitted a Pavement AMP by December 1, 2022. Allyson reminded the Committee that previous projects from 2021 must be closed out to be eligible for the 2023 funding. Please reach out to Allyson or Caitlin with any questions or if assistance is needed.

INDOT Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for Local Bridge Preventative Maintenance Projects Allyson stated INDOT released their NOFA for local bridge preventative maintenance type projects on January 2, 2023. It closes on January 31, 2023. Funds for new projects will cover construction of the project to be bid beginning in FY 28. Funding for other phases of the project will be awarded later.

US DOT RAISE Grant

Allyson stated the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant Program is currently open. Funding is available for surface transportation projects that will have a significant local or regional impact. The minimum award is \$5,000,000 in urban areas and \$1,000,000 in rural areas. Eligible applicants include local governments, transit agencies and multijurisdictional organizations. Applications are due February 28, 2023.

Plans and Programs

January Quarterly Tracking and Review Meeting

Allyson reminded the Committee that the next quarterly tracking and review meeting is January 12, 2023. The Quarterly Tracking Report Forms are due today.

CONNECT Transit Plan

Zach said the CONNECT Transit Plan is in its final phase. There are four public open houses next week in each of the major cities of the transit system: Mishawaka, South Bend, Elkhart, and Goshen. Zach recommended attending one of the public open houses to learn more about the CONNECT Transit Plan or visiting the website at www.connecttransitplan.com.
