James explained that the State manages the 5310 grant program for projects in Elkhart, Marshall, and Kosciusko Counties. The projects are seeking endorsements to apply for funding through the State and conform with the Coordinated Public Transit Human Services Plan. James said the potential purchases are for vehicles. Pam Landesman, of Marshall-Starke Development Center, provided an overview of their services and said they are requesting six buses because all of their buses have over 100,000 miles. James explained that the endorsement does not guarantee funding. The State will send a list of any projects that have been awarded and the projects will then be added to the Transportation Improvement Program.

James stated Royal Excursion has been awarded the Interurban Trolley Transit Services contract for the next five years.

Regional Safety Action Plan Contract Award

Caitlin stated Toole Design was awarded the Regional Safety Action Plan contract. She stated the intent of the plan is to cover the entire region and once it is complete, local jurisdictions within the region will be able to apply for the Safe Streets and Roads for All discretionary grant program.

INDOT Letting Preparation Schedule

Caitlin notified the Committee that INDOT will start requiring all documentation for projects going to letting be submitted by the final tracings date. James said he asked Kathy Eaton-McKalip if consultants will be scored and receive performance evaluations on their ability to hit the final tracings date. He also asked if environmental reviews could be more thorough. He will update the committee once he receives an answer from Kathy.

Quarterly Tracking and Review Meeting

Dana reminded the Committee that the next Quarterly Tracking and Review meeting will be on April 11. She will send an email reminder in the next couple of weeks.

Partners for Clean Air Award Nominations
