Dot It Privacy Policy

Introduction

Dot It is committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring the security of your personal information. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect your personal information when you use Dot It ("Platform"). Please read this policy carefully and contact us if you have any questions or concerns.

By using the Platform, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of your information as described in this Privacy Policy.

Information We Collect

We collect the following types of information when you use the Dot It Platform:

- Personal Information: Personal information you provide during registration, such as your name, email address, school or institution name, and your role (e.g., teacher or student).
- b. Assessment Data: Information related to your assessments, such as assessment questions, answers, scores, and progress reports.
- c. Usage Data: Information about how you interact with the Platform, such as login timestamps, browser type, device information, and IP address.

How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- a. To provide and improve the Dot It, including creating and managing your account, delivering assessments, and providing customer support.
- b. To analyze and monitor the usage of our Platform to improve its functionality, performance, and security.
- c. To communicate with you about updates, promotions, and other relevant information related to the Dot It Platform.
- d. To comply with applicable laws and regulations.

Sharing Your Information

We will not sell or rent your personal information to third parties. We may share your information with third parties under the following circumstances:

- a. Service Providers: We may share your information with trusted service providers who help us operate and maintain the Platform. These providers are contractually obligated to use your information only for the purposes we specify and to maintain its confidentiality and security.
- b. Legal Requirements: We may disclose your information if required to do so by law, or in response to a legal request, such as a subpoena or court order.
- c. Business Transfers: In the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, we may transfer your information to the new owner, subject to the same privacy commitments outlined in this policy.

Security

We take the security of your information seriously and implement industry-standard safeguards to protect it. However, no method of electronic transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

Children's Privacy

The Dot It Platform is intended for use by educators and students. If you are a parent or guardian and believe your child has provided us with personal information without your consent, please contact us to request the removal of their information.

Access and Control of Your Information

You have the right to access, update, or delete your personal information at any time. To do so, log in to your Dot It account or contact us for assistance.

COPPA Compliance

We at Dot it take the privacy of children under the age of 13 ("Minor Users") very seriously and have implemented additional safeguards and restrictions to help protect the Personal Data of these young users. Personal Data is only collected from a Minor User if a school official, such as a teacher or administrator, has obtained prior approval from the child's parent or guardian. The data will then only be used in a manner that benefits the educational environment.

If you are a student who is under the age of 13, please refrain from sending any Personal Data to us unless your school, teacher, or district has obtained prior consent from your parent or guardian. Only provide the specific information that we request as part of our Services. If it comes to our attention that we have inadvertently gathered Personal Data from a Minor User without the requisite parental approval, or if a Minor User has provided more information than requested, we will promptly remove such data. If you suspect that we have collected data in this manner, please reach out to us at support@dotit.app.

For schools, teachers, and districts, you are obligated to comply with COPPA regulations. This means you must obtain written parental consent in advance for any Minor Users who will access our Services. It is your responsibility to understand how any third-party software you may use in conjunction with Dot it's Services may collect and utilize user data. When securing parental approval, you are required to share this Privacy Policy. Keep all written consents on record and provide them to us upon request. Teachers, by using our Services, you confirm that you have the necessary permission from your educational institution or district, and you are responsible for adhering to COPPA guidelines on behalf of your institution or district.
