

CJI Surya Kant Highlights Reduction in Court Backlog Through Technology

Chief Justice of India Surya Kant stated that technology-driven initiatives have significantly reduced the court case backlog compared to past decades.

The **e-Courts** Integrated Mission Mode Project was conceptualized based on the National Policy and Action Plan for Implementation of ICT in Judiciary in **2005**.

The **E-Committee** of the Supreme Court of India was constituted in **2004** to formulate the national policy on ICT in the judicial system.

National Judicial Data Grid (NJDG) is a online platform created under e-Courts Project to track pending and disposed court cases nationwide.

Article 124 of the Constitution provides for the establishment and constitution of the **Supreme Court of India**.

Article 214 of the Indian Constitution mandates that there shall be a **High Court** for each State.

Fast Track Courts (FTCs) were recommended by the **11th Finance Commission** in **2000** for expeditious disposal of long-pending cases.
