

Census 2027: TN Self-Enumeration Begins July 17, 2026

The self-enumeration process for Census 2027 in Tamil Nadu is scheduled to begin on July 17, 2026.

Self-enumeration is the first phase of the Census, allowing individuals to digitally submit their demographic data through an online portal.

The **first complete Census** in India was conducted in **1881** under the administration of **Lord Ripon**.

The Census of India is conducted under the provisions of the **Census Act** of **1948**.

The **Registrar General and Census Commissioner of India**, under the **Ministry of Home Affairs**, is responsible for conducting the **decennial Census**.

The **last Census** of India was conducted in **2011**.

As per the **2011 Census**, the total population of **Tamil Nadu** was approximately **7.21 crore**.

The **literacy rate** of **Tamil Nadu**, according to the **2011 Census**, was **80.09%**.
