

Farmers' Body Urges DMK to Drop Mekedatu Tribunal Demand

The Coordination Committee of All Farmers Associations of Tamil Nadu urged the DMK to withdraw its demand for a tribunal on the Mekedatu project.

Mekedatu is a proposed multi-purpose dam project by Karnataka across the Cauvery river, which Tamil Nadu opposes due to concerns over water flow to its delta farmers.

The **Mekedatu project** involves constructing a balancing reservoir across the **Cauvery river** in **Karnataka's Ramanagara district**.

Tamil Nadu opposes the **Mekedatu project**, arguing it violates the **Cauvery Water Disputes Tribunal's final award** and the **Supreme Court's verdict**.

The **Cauvery Water Disputes Tribunal (CWDT)** was constituted in **1990** under the **Inter-State River Water Disputes Act, 1956**.

The **CWDT** issued its final award in **2007**, allocating water shares to **Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Kerala**, and **Puducherry**.

The **Supreme Court** modified the CWDT award in **2018**, reducing **Tamil Nadu's share** and increasing **Karnataka's share** of **Cauvery water**.

The **Cauvery river** is a major inter-state river flowing through **Karnataka** and **Tamil Nadu**, crucial for **agriculture** in both states.
