

Kharge Seeks All-Party Meet on Delimitation Proposals

Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge urged PM Modi to convene an all-party meeting on delimitation proposals.

Delimitation is the process of redrawing boundaries of Lok Sabha and State Assembly constituencies to ensure equal representation.

STATICS & SYLLABUS FOCUS

Article 82 of the Indian Constitution mandates that Parliament enacts a **Delimitation Act** after every **census**.

Article 170 specifies that states are divided into **territorial constituencies** as per the Delimitation Act.

A **Delimitation Commission** is appointed by the **President of India** and functions under the **Delimitation Commission Act**.

The Commission's orders have the **force of law** and **cannot be challenged** in any court of law.

The **42nd Amendment Act** of **1976** froze the delimitation exercise until the **2001 census**.

The **84th Amendment Act** of **2001** extended this freeze on the number of **Lok Sabha and Assembly seats** until the year **2026**.

The **last major delimitation** exercise was carried out by the Delimitation Commission of **2002**, headed by **Justice Kuldip Singh**.
