

M.K. Stalin: NEET Failed, Trust States

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin addressed student protests following the NEET question paper leak, advocating for states' autonomy in medical admissions.

NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) is a national-level entrance examination for admission to undergraduate medical courses in India, which has faced criticism regarding its implementation and fairness.

STATICS & SYLLABUS FOCUS

NEET was initially introduced by the **Medical Council of India (MCI)** and **Dental Council of India (DCI)**.

The **Supreme Court of India** mandated the implementation of **NEET** for medical admissions in **2016**.

NEET replaced the **All India Pre-Medical Test (AIPMT)** and various state-level medical entrance examinations.

The **National Testing Agency (NTA)** has been responsible for administering the **NEET examination** since **2019**.

Education is listed under the **Concurrent List** of the **Seventh Schedule** of the Indian Constitution, allowing both the Centre and States to legislate.

The **Tamil Nadu government** constituted the **Justice A.K. Rajan Committee** in **2021** to study the impact of **NEET** on medical admissions in the state.

Article 200 of the Indian Constitution outlines the powers of the Governor regarding assent to Bills passed by the **State Legislature**.

Article 201 of the Constitution deals with **Bills reserved by the Governor** for the consideration of the **President**.
