Viksit Bharat 2047 represents the government's roadmap to transform India into a developed nation by the centenary of its independence.

PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan was launched in **October 2021** to ensure integrated multimodal connectivity infrastructure.

India set a target to achieve **Net Zero** carbon emissions by the year **2070** at the **COP26** summit in Glasgow.

Make in India initiative was launched on **September 25, 2014**, to foster domestic manufacturing and investment.

The Vedic term '**Sapta Sindhu**' referred to the **Indus** and its six tributaries: Vitasta, Asikni, Parushni, Vipasa, Sutudri, and Saraswati.

Article 51A(h) of the Indian Constitution directs citizens to develop scientific temper, humanism, and the spirit of inquiry and reform.
