The **Rajya Sabha** is the **upper house** of the **Indian Parliament**, representing the **states and union territories**.

Article 79 of the **Indian Constitution** states that the **Parliament** consists of the **President**, the **Lok Sabha**, and the **Rajya Sabha**.

Article 80 of the **Indian Constitution** deals with the **composition of the Rajya Sabha**.

The **Vice-President of India** serves as the **ex-officio Chairman** of the **Rajya Sabha**.

The three main sessions of the **Indian Parliament** are the **Budget Session**, **Monsoon Session**, and **Winter Session**.
