

SFI Protests NEET-UG Irregularities in Kerala

The Students' Federation of India (SFI) staged statewide protests in Kerala against alleged NEET-UG exam irregularities.

NEET-UG is a national-level entrance examination conducted for admission to undergraduate medical and dental courses in India.

The **National Testing Agency (NTA)** was established in **2017**.

NTA is an autonomous and self-sustained premier testing organization under the **Ministry of Education**.

NEET-UG replaced the **All India Pre-Medical Test (AIPMT)** and various state-level medical entrance exams.

The **National Medical Commission (NMC)** regulates **medical education** and professionals in India.

Education is listed under the **Concurrent List** of the **Seventh Schedule** of the Indian Constitution.

The **Supreme Court** upheld the validity of **NEET** in **2016**.

The **National Medical Commission Act, 2019**, replaced the **Medical Council of India Act, 1956**.
