

Sonam Wangchuk Hospitalised; CJP Founder Plans Parliament March

Activist Sonam Wangchuk was forcibly hospitalized during his hunger strike, while CJP founder Abhijeet Dipke was detained amid protests over NEET-UG irregularities.

This news concerns protests led by activist Sonam Wangchuk and the Cockroach Janta Party (CJP) against alleged irregularities in the NEET-UG examination, leading to police action and hospitalization.

- The **Cockroach Janta Party (CJP)** is leading protests demanding action from **Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan** regarding **NEET-UG**.
- The **CJP founder** has vowed to march to **Parliament** on **July 20**.

The **National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (Undergraduate)**, or **NEET-UG**, is a **national-level** entrance examination for admission to undergraduate medical courses in India.

Jantar Mantar in **New Delhi** is a historical site and a designated location for **public protests** and demonstrations.

The **right to protest peacefully** is a **fundamental right** guaranteed under **Article 19(1)(a)** (freedom of speech and expression) and **Article 19(1)(b)** (right to assemble peacefully) of the **Indian Constitution**.

Safdarjung Hospital, a major multi-specialty hospital in **New Delhi**, operates under the **Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare**.

The **Delhi High Court** was established on **October 31, 1966**, and has jurisdiction over the **National Capital Territory of Delhi**.

The **Union Minister of Education** is the head of the **Ministry of Education**, responsible for the formulation and implementation of **national education policies**.

The **Parliament of India** is the **supreme legislative body** of the Republic of India, consisting of the **President**, the **Lok Sabha** (House of the People), and the **Rajya Sabha** (Council of States).
