

Supreme Court Urges Peace, End to Manipur Highway Blockades

The Supreme Court urged Kuki and Meitei groups to end blockades on National Highways in Manipur.

The **Supreme Court of India** is the apex judicial body and the **guardian of the Indian Constitution**.

Article 32 of the Indian Constitution grants citizens the right to move the Supreme Court for the enforcement of **Fundamental Rights**.

National Highways in India are primarily developed and maintained by the **National Highways Authority of India (NHAI)** under the Union **Ministry of Road Transport and Highways**.

Manipur is a **northeastern state** of India, sharing an international border with **Myanmar**.

The **Chief Justice of India**, who heads the Supreme Court, is appointed by the **President of India**.

Law and Order is a **State Subject**, falling under Entry 1 of the State List in the **Seventh Schedule** of the Indian Constitution.

The **Kuki and Meitei communities** are major ethnic groups residing in **Manipur**, often involved in socio-political dynamics of the region.
