

Supreme Court Verdict on Super-Speciality Seats Welcomed by TNGDA

Tamil Nadu Government Doctors Association welcomed the Supreme Court ruling on super-speciality seats, anticipating more opportunities for state doctors.

A Supreme Court verdict addressing counselling norms and seat availability for super-speciality medical courses (DM/MCh) for in-service government doctors.

STATICS & SYLLABUS FOCUS

Article 15(4) of the Indian Constitution empowers the State to make special provisions for the educational advancement of socially and educationally backward classes.

Tamil Nadu allocates a **50% in-service quota** for government doctors in postgraduate medical seats and super-speciality courses.

In **K. Duraisamy v. State of Tamil Nadu (2001)**, the Supreme Court recognized the competence of states to provide separate quotas for in-service candidates.

Entry 25 of List III (**Concurrent List**) in the 7th Schedule deals with Education, including technical and medical education, subject to Entry 66 of List I.

The **Directorate of Medical Education and Research (DMER)** in Tamil Nadu functions under the Department of Health and Family Welfare to manage medical education.

Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program (TNHSRP) is implemented with financial assistance from the **World Bank** to achieve Sustainable Development Goal 3 (**SDG 3**).
