

TN Budget 2026-27: Technical Textiles Mission and New Tech Centre Announced

The Tamil Nadu Budget 2026-27 announced key initiatives including the Technical Textiles Transformation Scheme and a new technology centre in Tiruppur.

It is a government initiative to promote technical textile entrepreneurship and industrial development across the western districts of Tamil Nadu.

Tiruppur is known as the '**Knitwear Capital of India**' and accounts for a major share of India's cotton knitwear exports.

Coimbatore is widely referred to as the '**Manchester of South India**' due to its extensive textile industrial base.

Technical textiles refer to textile materials and products manufactured primarily for technical performance and functional properties rather than aesthetic features.

The Ministry of Textiles launched the **National Technical Textiles Mission** (NTTM) in **2020** for a four-year implementation period.

The **Handloom Export Promotion Council** (HEPC) is a nodal agency headquartered in **Chennai**, Tamil Nadu.
