

TN CM Urges PM to Fast-Track Godavari-Cauvery-Gundar River Link

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister requested PM Narendra Modi to expedite the Godavari-Cauvery-Gundar river linking project and form a Special Purpose Vehicle.

Godavari-Cauvery-Gundar link is a peninsular river interlinking project designed to divert surplus water from the Godavari basin to water-stressed regions in Tamil Nadu.

STATICS & SYLLABUS FOCUS

National Water Development Agency (NWDA) was established in **1982** to study river interlinking feasibility under the National Perspective Plan.

Peninsular Rivers Development Component comprises **16 river link proposals** across southern India.

The Intra-State **Cauvery-Vaigai-Gundar link** in Tamil Nadu channels surplus Cauvery water from **Maya-nur** (Kattalai Regulator) to Gundar river.

Article 262 of the Indian Constitution grants Parliament exclusive power to adjudicate inter-state river water disputes.

Inter-State River Water Disputes Act was enacted by Parliament in **1956** under Article 262.

Central Water Commission (CWC) was set up in **1945** as an attached office under the Ministry of Jal Shakti.

REVISION FLASHCARD

NWDA, established in 1982, executes river interlinking studies under Article 262 provisions.
