

TN Govt to Withdraw Cases Against Anti-NEET Student Protesters

The Tamil Nadu government announced the withdrawal of all cases registered against students who participated in anti-NEET protests.

State government policy decision to dismiss police cases filed against students involved in agitations demanding NEET exemption in Tamil Nadu.

KEY EXAM POINTS

- **School Education Minister** announced that the **Tamil Nadu government** will withdraw all cases registered against students who protested against **NEET**.
- The decision was taken based on the directions of the **Chief Minister** of **Tamil Nadu**.
- This move aligns Tamil Nadu with other **State governments** that have previously dropped charges against student demonstrators.
- The protests were directed against the **National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test** conducted for undergraduate **medical admissions** in India.
- Student groups across **Tamil Nadu** had organized demonstrations opposing the single entrance examination for medical college admissions.

STATICS & SYLLABUS FOCUS

The **Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly** passed a bill in **September 2021** seeking exemption for the State from the **NEET** examination.

High Level Committee headed by retired High Court Judge **A.K. Rajan** was constituted by the TN government in **June 2021** to study NEET impact.

Under **Article 254(2)** of the Constitution, a State law on a **Concurrent List** subject requires the **President's assent** if conflicting with a Central law.

NEET was introduced across India by the **National Medical Commission Act, 2019**, replacing the **Indian Medical Council Act, 1956**.

Education was transferred from the State List to the **Concurrent List** of the Indian Constitution by the **42nd Constitutional Amendment Act, 1976**.

Article 21A of the Constitution guarantees the fundamental right to free and compulsory education for children aged **6 to 14 years**.

Medical education in India is regulated centrally by the **National Medical Commission** (NMC), established in **September 2020**.
