

TN to Offer ₹10 Lakh Aid to Families of Tamils Killed in Karnataka

Tamil Nadu government proposed ₹10 lakh compensation for families of three Tamils killed by Karnataka Forest personnel.

This is a proposed financial assistance from the Tamil Nadu government to support the families of individuals who lost their lives in an inter-state incident.

The **Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund (CMPRF)** provides financial assistance to individuals and families affected by natural calamities, accidents, and other unforeseen circumstances in Tamil Nadu.

The **Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly** is a **unicameral** legislature with **234** elected members and one nominated member.

The **Tamil Nadu Forest Department** is responsible for the **protection**, conservation, and management of forests and wildlife in the state.

The **Tamil Nadu Forest Act** of **1882** is one of the foundational legal frameworks governing forest administration in the state.

Article 263 of the Indian Constitution provides for the establishment of an **Inter-State Council** to promote coordination between states and the Union.

A **magisterial inquiry** is a formal investigation conducted by an **Executive Magistrate** into incidents involving deaths in police custody or other specific circumstances.
