The **first AIIMS** was established in **New Delhi** in **1956** through an **Act of Parliament**.

M. Karunanidhi served as the **Chief Minister** of Tamil Nadu for **five terms** between **1969** and **2011**.

Porur is a significant residential and commercial locality situated in the southwestern part of **Chennai, Tamil Nadu**.

Madurai, often called the '**Temple City**', is one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world and a major **cultural hub** in Tamil Nadu.

Development of **health infrastructure** is a core component of **Tamil Nadu's development administration**, aiming for **universal healthcare access**.

The **Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program (TNHSRP)** is a **World Bank-supported** initiative to improve health services in the state.
